TO DISCUSS A PROPOSAL FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

The City of Durant submitted a grant application on June 30, 2020 to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) through the Small Cities Set Aside Program. The City of Durant will hold an Application Phase Public Hearing presenting the grant proposal information for the electrical and controls system improvements necessary for the city-owned Water Treatment Plant, to benefit all Durant citizens. If funded, the proposed project would be partially financed with FY 20 Community Development Block Grant funds.

According to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce's Income guidelines, the project will benefit at least 51% low and moderate-income residents.

All interested citizens are invited to attend the public hearing. Topics of discussion will include: OK State CDBG Program purpose, design and emphasis; the proposed City of Durant FY 20 CDBG Small Cities Project, to include project purpose and description.
